



Crochet Guild of America Square of the Month

Sedona Rainfall *Designed by Karen Klemp*

About the Designer: Karen Klemp is a crochet and jewelry designer whose creations have been featured in numerous books and magazines, in the CGOA pattern line, and in her own pattern collection -- Almost Amy Designs. Karen was president of the Crochet Guild of America from 1999-2001. She teaches workshops at many regional and national fiber arts conferences as well as locally, in Northern Virginia.

Skill Level: Advanced beginner

Size: 12 by 12 inches

Materials

Worsted weight yarn: 2 oz natural (B), 1 oz each soft rust (A) and green heather (C)
Crochet hook size 1/9 or size needed for gauge



Gauge: 7 Sc = 2 inches; 6 pattern rows = 2 inches

Square:

Row 1: With color A ch 43, sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across, ch 2, turn. (42 sc)

Row 2: *Sk next st, insert hook in next sc, yo, draw up lp, yo and draw through 2 lps on hook, with color B yo and draw through rem 2 lps on hook, working over dc just made, insert hook in sk st, yo, draw up lp, yo and draw through 2 lps on hook, with color A yo and draw through rem 2 lps on hook, rep from * across, end with dc in last sc changing to color B, fasten off color A, ch 1, turn. (20 crossed bi-color sts)

Row 3: With B sc in each dc across, ch 2, turn. (42 sc)

Row 4: With colors B and C rep Row 2, changing to C in last dc, fasten off color B.

Row 5: With color C rep Row 3.

Row 6: With colors C and B rep Row 2.

Row 7: With color B rep Row 3.

Row 8: With colors B and A rep Row 2.

Row 9: With color A rep Row 3.

Rows 10—33: Rep [Rows 2—9] 3 times, at end of Row 33 fasten off.
